

**MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF  
THE MACON MOSQUITO ABATEMENT DISTRICT  
APRIL 21, 2016**

The regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Macon Mosquito Abatement District was called to order by Ryan Raleigh on April 21, 2016, at the office of the Macon Mosquito Abatement District at 3755 Cundiff Road, Decatur, Illinois 62526. Trustees present were Carol Carlton, Ryan Raleigh, Tom McQuiston and Sue Phillips. Also present were Jackie Evans-Moser and Attorney Edward F. Flynn. Absent was Dr. Robert Groesch. Ryan Raleigh presided over the meeting.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

There were no comments during public comments.

The meeting was opened and a motion to approve the Minutes was made by Tom McQuiston, seconded by Sue Phillips, and unanimously approved.

There was a motion made to approve the checks by Carol Carlton, seconded by Tom McQuiston, and unanimously approved.

There were no comments during old business.

During new business, the Board extensively discussed the health insurance concerns regarding Sam Force. The Board directed Jackie Evans-Moser to increase the salary of Sam Force by \$6,000.00 retroactive to February 1, 2016, and Sam will be responsible for purchasing his own insurance. The salary increase is significantly less than the cost of adding Sam Force to the District Plan.

During Superintendent's comments, Jackie Evans-Moser reported that the District had finally filled the biology/testing position with a Millikin student. The summer staff is now complete. Jackie Evans-Moser and Sam Force will be attending the

Northern Illinois arbovirus annual meeting that will discuss current Zika virus information. Jackie Evans-Moser is going to actively reach out to the Health Department and the County EEHW Committee to update the community on the Zika virus issues. Jackie Evans-Moser is working with the Macon County Health Department to hold a One Hour Mosquito-Prevention Larvicide training for governmental entities to apply pre-measured larvicide to kill mosquito larvae.

There were no comments during Trustee comments.

There were no comments during Miscellaneous Business and Open Discussion.

Subsequently, a motion was made by Carol Carlton, seconded by Tom McQuiston and unanimously approved for adjournment.
