

**MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF  
THE MACON MOSQUITO ABATEMENT DISTRICT  
SEPTEMBER 17, 2015**

The regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Macon Mosquito Abatement District was called to order by Lisle Ellis on September 17, 2015, at the office of the Macon Mosquito Abatement District at 3755 Cundiff Road, Decatur, Illinois 62526. Trustees present were Lisle Ellis, Dr. Robert Groesch, Carol Carlton, Ryan Raleigh and Tom McQuiston. Also present were Jackie Evans-Moser and Attorney Edward F. Flynn. Lisle Ellis presided over the meeting.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

There were no comments made during public comments.

The meeting was opened and a motion to approve the Minutes was made by Ryan Raleigh, seconded by Carol Carlton, and unanimously approved.

There was a motion made to approve the checks by Ryan Raleigh, seconded by Carol Carlton, and unanimously approved.

During discussion of adopting the 2015-2016 Levy Ordinance 15-2, Attorney Edward F. Flynn discussed the levy ordinance; following the discussion, Ryan Raleigh moved to adopt the levy ordinance and Dr. Robert Groesch seconded the motion, which was unanimously approved.

There were no comments made during old business.

There were no comments made during new business.

During Superintendent's comments, Jackie Evans-Moser discussed the West Nile virus concerns that lead to spraying adult mosquitos. The areas sprayed were South Shores, the area hear Heinkel Packing; residential areas near Locust; Larkdale; and Woodridge area. Four areas were treated resulting in 26 linear miles. These areas were trapped the next day and the results showed that the adult spray was successful.

Statewide there are 22 confirmed West Nile cases and three deaths. The deaths were in the Chicago area.

There were no comments made during Trustee comments.

There were no comments made during Miscellaneous Business and Open Discussion.

Subsequently, a motion was made by Carol Carlton, seconded by Tom McQuiston and unanimously approved for adjournment.
